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INFORMATION FOR NEW MEMBERS

GENERAL

Thank you for choosing to join Charlestown Golf Club.

This package is designed to give you information regarding choices of membership available.

Charlestown Golf Club is a picturesque and challenging 18 hole layout which will challenge golfers of all levels. The club house hosts a friendly atmosphere, combined with sweeping views of the course. The award winning professional shop is fully staffed by qualified professional coaches, and boasts a full range of golf equipment, golf merchandise and clothing.

The course, club house and professional shop is open to members and visitors 7 days a week.

CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

- **Ordinary Members** over 18 years who are entitled to play in all unconditional competitions.
- **Interim Ordinary Members** over 18 years who are waiting ordinary membership when number limits are in force. They are entitled to play in Saturday competitions, but cannot use the timesheet until the Friday night prior.
- **6 Day Associate Members** over 18 years who do not wish to play Saturdays.
- **Colts Members** under 23 years, and have all golfing entitlements of ordinary members.
- **Junior- Male & Female Members** are those under 18 years, and have all golfing entitlements of ordinary members.
- **Social Members** over 18 years wishing to enjoy the club house facilities only.



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APPROVAL OF MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS

- All applications must be signed by a proposer and seconder who are members of the Club.
- Membership fees are to be paid at time of application. Fees will be refunded in full if membership is not approved.
- Applicant details will be displayed in the club house for one week prior to approval.
- Consideration of all membership applications will be made at the next full Board meeting following the above.
- New memberships shall be advised in writing following approval by the Board.
- A comprehensive membership welcoming package, including membership card, will be given to all new members at this time. This package details golf competitions and requirements, club house opening times and facilities available, as well as professional shop resources, and coaching and golf academy training packages.



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INITIAL AGU HANDICAP

The following points should be adhered to for those Members seeking an AGU handicap. Members with existing handicaps should be aware of the following procedure, as they will then be able to assist any new AGU golfers.

Applicant information should contain:

- Note at top of card 'For Handicap'
- Applicants full name (block letters)
- Membership number
- Scratch score for 18 holes per card and totaled
- Members signature as 'Player'
- The date the round was played regardless of the date the card was issued.
- At least 3 of the initial 5 cards required must be played at Charlestown

Marker information should contain:

- The marker must be a golfer affiliated with the AGU or WGA
- Marker should indicate full name (block letters)
- Marker should provide membership number
- The marker should indicate which club if not a member at Charlestown
- Signature as 'Marker'

General Information:

- Cards lodged for handicap shall be placed in the box provided
- Members should return cards as soon as practical after the round
- Members should check the computer to find their allocated **handicap**
- All problem cards will be returned to the player for correction. These should then be placed in the handicap box.
- All inquiries should be directed to the Handicapper.
