



## Charlestown Square Veterans Cup

### Conditions of entry

12<sup>th</sup> August 2010



#### Rules of entry:-

- All Charlestown Golf Club entrants must be members of Charlestown Veteran Golfers.
- All visiting entrants must be affiliated members of a veteran golfers association with a current GA handicap.
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt until the time sheet is filled or until the closing date of Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> August.
- Late entries will be accepted if vacancies are available on the time sheet.
- Entry fee must accompany the application.
- No refund will be made for cancellations after the closing date for entries.
- Tee times will be displayed from Monday 9<sup>th</sup> August and published in the Newcastle Herald Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August.

#### Handicaps:-

- All visiting players must produce proof of current handicap.
- Maximum handicaps Men 36, Ladies 45.

#### Format:-

- 8:00am Shotgun Start
- The Charlestown Veterans Cup will be played as an 18 holes medley Stableford competition over the field.
- In conjunction with the Cup, male and female Stableford handicap divisions will be played dependant on the number of entries.

#### Prizes:-

- First and Runner-up in the Veterans Cup over the field.
- First to third in each division.
- Players shall be eligible to win only one prize other than NTP's and Long Drives.
- Ball competition per division excluding Cup and division prize winners.
- NTP's in divisions:
  - Men on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> holes.
  - Ladies on the 6<sup>th</sup> hole and second shot on the 16<sup>th</sup> hole.
  - All in on the 2<sup>nd</sup> hole
  - All in second shot on the 9<sup>th</sup> hole.
- Longest Drive in divisions on the 17<sup>th</sup> hole.
- The Presentation will be held in the Clubhouse during lunch at the conclusion of the competition.

#### Competition:-

- The competition will be controlled by the Charlestown Veteran Golfers match committee who reserve the right to alter any conditions as seen fit, and any such decisions will be final.
- Tied scores will be decided by the Charlestown Programme booklet count back system and if still tied after application of the count back system, the toss of a coin.
- Motorised transport will be permitted; however the event will not be postponed if course conditions do not allow the use of motorised transport.
- All personally supplied forms of motorised transport must be covered by third party personal liability insurance.
- The local rules displayed on the back of the score card and those displayed on the local rule boards outside the pro-shop and on the veranda of the club house will apply.

#### Golf carts:-

- Players wishing to hire, or use, golf carts are asked to indicate so on the application form and with whom they wish to share, if applicable.
- Players are responsible for booking golf carts for the event at the Pro-Shop in person or by phoning 49438748.
